ProMedica Memorial Hospital is a 43 licensed-bed hospital that continues to offer comprehensive, compassionate medical care to the communities we serve.

Recent highlights include:

- **ProMedica Memorial Hospital** welcomed two new providers in 2024. **Sabeeha Shaik, MD**, pediatrics; and **Kayla Frank, CNP**, behavioral health.
- Passed the yearly **Mammography Quality Standards Act (MQSA) inspection by the FDA**.
- Recognized with **2024 Performance Leadership Awards for Excellence in Outcomes**.
- Earned Stroke **GoldPlus** from the *American Heart Association's Get with the Guidelines* program. This recognition shows that **Memorial Hospital** holds the most up-to-date, evidence-based treatment guidelines to improve patient care and outcomes in the communities we serve.
- **Memorial Hospital Auxiliary** awarded \$25,000 in scholarships to local students studying for health care degrees. **Memorial Hospital Foundation** awarded \$11,000 in scholarships and the **Memorial Hospital Medical staff** awarded \$7,500 in scholarships.
- Received an **"A" Hospital Safety Grade** from *The Leapfrog Group* for spring of 2024. This national distinction celebrates **Memorial Hospital's** achievements in protecting hospital patients from preventable harm and errors.
- The **Fremont Eagles** made a generous donation of over \$18,500 to the **Dorothy L. Kern Cancer Center** and **Kramer Heflinger Pediatric Endowment Fund**.
- The **Memorial Hospital Foundation** invested nearly \$400,000 into **Memorial Hospital**. Funds were used for new surgical equipment, an automated chest compression machine for the emergency department, a breast MRI coil for breast screening, sleep lab equipment, **Dorothy L. Kern Cancer Center** transportation services, community and patient assistance programs, health care scholarships and employee wellness initiatives.
